ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR

NOW, on this 2nd day of August, 2017, Chlora Lindley-Myers, Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration (the "Director" of the "Department") finds that Missouri Professionals Mutual-Physicians Professional Indemnity Association ("MPM-PPIA") is an association licensed under the provisions of sections 383.010 to 383.040, RSMo, finds that MPM-PPIA has been in operation at least two full calendar years, finds that based on an amended financial statement filed by MPM-PPIA with the Department on July 31, 2017, MPM-PPIA held negative surplus as regards policyholders of \$(24,478) as of March 31, 2017, which the Director finds to be conclusive and credible evidence indicating the surplus as regards policyholders of MPM-PPIA is less than zero dollars, and does hereby issue the following orders pursuant to section 383.035.5, RSMo:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that MPM-PPIA shall submit, within ninety days following this Order of the Director, a voluntary plan under which MPM-PPIA will restore its surplus as regards policyholders to at least zero dollars.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Director may monitor the performance of MPM-PPIA's plan and may order modifications thereto, including assessments or rate or premium increases, if MPM-PPIA fails to meet any targets proposed in such plan for three consecutive quarters.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
