SUMMARY ORDER OF REVOCATION

JOHN M. HUFF, Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions, and Professional Registration, hereby issues the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Summary Order of Revocation.

Findings of Fact

1. John M. Huff is the duly appointed Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions, and Professional Registration (hereinafter, "Director" of the "Department"). The Director has the duty to administer Chapters 374, 375, and 381 RSMo, which includes the supervision, regulation, and discipline of insurance companies, agencies, and producers licensed to operate and conduct business

in the State of Missouri.

2. The Department issued Respondent Senior Title Agency, LLC, a business entity producer license (No. AG8020843), which expired January 4, 2008.

3. The Department issued Respondent All American Title Agency, LLC, a business entity producer license (No. AG8020842), which expired January 4, 2008.

4. On December 23, 2008, the Director filed a Complaint before the Administrative Hearing Commission ("AHC"), Case No. 08-2128 DI, against Respondents alleging that he has cause to discipline Respondents' respective business entity insurance producer licenses pursuant to §§375.141.1(2), (8), and (9) RSMo Supp. 2008, for:

- a. Violating the insurance laws of the state of Illinois;
- b. Using fraudulent or dishonest practices, or demonstrating untrustworthiness or financial irresponsibility in the conduct of business in the state of Illinois; and
- c. Having their respective insurance licenses, or their equivalents being revoked in the state of Illinois.

5. On December 31, 2008, the AHC attempted to serve the Director's Complaint on Respondents by certified mail at the addresses Respondents had on file with the Department. The AHC was unable to obtain service on Respondents.

6. Both the AHC and the Director have attempted to send various pleadings to Respondents at the addresses Respondents have on file with the Department, however, all have been returned as undeliverable, with no forwarding address.

7. Section 375.141.5 provides:

Every insurance producer licensed in this state shall notify the director of any change of address, on forms prescribed by the director, within thirty days of the change. If the failure to notify the director of the change of address results in an inability to serve the insurance producer with a complaint as provided by sections 621.045 to 621.198, RSMo, then the director may immediately revoke the license of the insurance producer until such time as service may be obtained.

Conclusions of Law

8. Pursuant to §375.141, the Director has the discretion to discipline Respondents' respective business entity insurance licenses, including revocation of such licenses.

9. Pursuant to §375.141.5, such revocation may be immediate when an insurance producer's failure to notify the Director of any change of address within thirty (30) days of the change results in an inability to serve the insurance producer with a complaint as provided by §§621.045 to 621.198 RSMo. Such revocation may be effective until such time as service may be obtained.

### SUMMARY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the business entity insurance producer license of Senior Title Agency, LLC, (No. AG8020843) is REVOKED until such time as service of the Complaint filed with the Administrative Hearing Commission on December 23, 2008, Case No. 08-2128 DI, may be obtained or until such time as service of a complaint in a future Administrative Hearing Commission action against Senior Title Agency, LLC, may be obtained.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the business entity insurance producer license of All American Title Agency, LLC, (No. AG8020842) is REVOKED until such time as service of the Complaint filed with the Administrative Hearing Commission on December 23, 2008, Case No. 08-2128 DI, may be obtained or until such time as service of a complaint in a future Administrative Hearing Commission action against All American Title Agency, LLC, may be obtained.
