

Additional Information Request provided to the Licensing Section that stated "I received a DWI".

5. On Question 37 of the application which requires a list of employment for the previous five years, Applicant stated that he worked for Stewart Title in Marketing and for Chicago Title, but did not state a position held.
6. On September 20, 2005, Investigator Gerald Michitsch wrote to Applicant asking for a description of his job duties at Stewart Title and Chicago Title, in addition to asking for a written statement and documentation on the conviction as required by the application. Applicant failed to respond to this written request.
7. Two more attempts were made by the Investigator, on December 15, 2005, and on February 15, 2006, to obtain the information requested.
8. Applicant spoke with the Investigator on January 9, 2006, and promised to respond in writing as soon as possible. Applicant failed to respond.
9. This order is in the public interest.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

10. Section 375.141.1 RSMo Cum Supp 2005 provides:

The director may suspend, revoke, refuse to issue or refuse to renew an insurance producer license for any one or more of the following causes:

(1) Intentionally providing materially ... incomplete ... information in the license application;

(2) Violating any insurance laws...; [or]

(8) ...demonstrating incompetence, ...in the conduct of business in this state;

11. Section 374.210 RSMo 2000 provides, in part:

2. Any person who shall refuse to give such director full and truthful information, and answer in writing to any inquiry or question made in writing by the director, in regard to the business of insurance carried on by such

person...shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor...

12. Applicant has intentionally provided incomplete information in his application, a ground for refusal under Section 375.141.1(1) RSMo Cum Supp 2005.
13. Applicant has refused to give the director full and truthful information, and answer in writing to any inquiry or question made in writing by the director, in regard to the business of insurance carried on by Applicant in violation of Section 374.210.2 RSMo 2000, a ground for refusal under Section 375.141.1(2) RSMo Cum Supp 2005.
14. Applicant has demonstrated incompetence in the conduct of business in this state, a ground for refusal under Section 375.141.1(8) RSMo Cum Supp 2005.
15. This order is in the public interest.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the issuance of the insurance producer license of Applicant Patrick G. Fahey is hereby summarily REFUSED.
