

5. Applicant answered the question "Yes".
6. Applicant disclosed and, in fact, was convicted of the following of felonies or crimes involving moral turpitude in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, County of Lycoming District Court:
 - A. December 1, 1993, Attempted Possession of Cocaine, placed on one year probation;
 - B. December 7, 1993, Possession of a Controlled Substance, sentenced to fifteen days in the county jail;
 - C. January 21, 1999, Theft by Unlawful Taking, placed on nine months probation; and
 - D. January 11, 2000, Simple Assault, sentenced to pay fine and ordered participation in a drug rehabilitation program.
7. Applicant's inexperience in the insurance business, history of drug use, and criminal behavior, in a telemarketing sales structure, presents an high degree of risk for misleading and unsuitable sales to Missouri consumers.
8. This order is in the public interest.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9. Section 375.141.1 RSMo Cum Supp 2004 provides, in part:

The director may suspend, revoke, refuse to issue or refuse to renew an insurance producer license for any one or more of the following causes:

(6) Having been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude.
10. Applicant has been convicted of Attempted Possession of Cocaine, Possession of a Controlled Substance, Theft by Unlawful Taking and Simple Assault, a ground for refusal of the license under Section 375.141.1(6) RSMo Cum Supp 2004.
11. This order is in the public interest.

ORDER


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the issuance of the insurance producer license of Applicant Jason Garrett Bennett is hereby summarily REFUSED.


NOTICE
