CONSENT ORDER LIMITING BUSINESS UNDER WAIVER

W. DALE FINKE, Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance, after reviewing the stipulations set forth herein, hereby issues the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order:

Findings of Fact

1. W. Dale Finke is the duly appointed Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance (hereinafter, Director) whose duties, pursuant to Chapter 375, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of insurance.

2. The Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance is charged with investigating pursuant to §374.085, RSMo 2000 and is authorized by the director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to insurance.

3. Respondent Robert A. Beamer ("Beamer") is not licensed as an insurance producer in the State of Missouri. Beamer intends to be employed with Residential Title Services, Inc., a Missouri insurance producer, providing computer services.

4. On July 12, 1985, Beamer entered a plea of guilty to, and was convicted of, a felony under the laws of the United States, to wit: interstate transportation of stolen checks, in the United States District Court, Eastern District of Wisconsin, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §2314, subjecting him to disqualification from the business of insurance under 18 U.S.C. §1033.

5. Beamer has requested a waiver from the Director.

6. The Consumer Affairs Division and Beamer desire to settle this matter and consent to the issuance of this order.

7. Beamer, without any admission of a violation of the law, waives the right to a hearing to contest any provision of this order and has stipulated and agreed to the issuance of this order without further proceedings in this matter, agreeing to be fully bound by the terms and conditions specified herein.

8. Beamer has stipulated and agreed to waive any rights that he may have to seek judicial review or other challenge or contest to the terms and conditions of this order and forever releases and holds harmless the Department of Insurance, the director and his agents from any and all liability and claims arising out of, pertaining to or relating to this matter.

9. The director is authorized to enforce this order and should Beamer fail to comply with the conditions set forth herein, the director or his successors, without any

limitation, may suspend, revoke, or cancel a waiver of his disqualification under 18 U.S.C. §1033.

Conclusions of Law

10. The Director may impose orders in the public interest under §374.046, RSMo.

ORDER

IT IS NOW, THEREFORE, ORDERED that pursuant to the Insurance Fraud Prevention Act of 1994, 18 U.S.C. §1033(e)(2), the Director waives Beamer's disqualification under federal law, subject to the following conditions:

- A. Beamer remains exclusively associated with Residential Title Services, Inc. and Title Marketing Co., Inc., a Missouri Corporation, in the capacity of operating and providing computer services;
- B. Residential Title Services, Inc. remains licensed as an insurance producer in the State of Missouri and Title Marketing Co., Inc. remains a Missouri corporation in good standing.
