The Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions, and Professional Registration has received your nonresident producer renewal application. You failed to disclose within thirty days the administrative action received from North Carolina. This matter is grounds for suspension, revocation, or refusal to renew the nonresident producer license based on the following Missouri statute:

Section 375.141.6 RSMo (Supp. 2009) - An insurance producer shall report to the director any administrative action taken against the producer in another jurisdiction or by another governmental agency in this state within thirty days of the final disposition of the matter. This report shall include a copy of the order, consent order or other relevant legal documents.

I am prepared to report this matter to the Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance with a recommendation to refuse to renew the license, but in order to resolve this matter, I recommend that you pay a voluntary forfeiture in the amount of \$250.00. Please consider this option and consult with counsel if you wish.

Be aware that imposition of this fine is an administrative action that you may be required to report to other states in which you are licensed.

Enclosed is a Voluntary Forfeiture Agreement in the amount of \$250.00. Please date, sign, and return the original document with a cashier's check or money order made payable to the Missouri State School Fund. Please return the original to my attention.

VOLUNTARY FORFEITURE

It is hereby agreed by Raymond Snyder and the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, as follows:

WHEREAS, John M. Huff is the duly appointed Director of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, State of Missouri, (hereinafter, Director) whose duties, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of insurance;

WHEREAS, the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration is charged with investigating producers and companies engaged in the business of insurance pursuant to Sections 374.085 and 374.190, RSMo 2000 and is authorized by the Director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to insurance;

WHEREAS, Raymond Snyder has applied to renew his license as a nonresident producer with the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo;

WHEREAS, information has been received by the Consumer Affairs Division that Raymond Snyder failed to report an administrative action within thirty days of the final disposition of the matter, which is grounds for discipline under Section 375.141.6 RSMo (Supp. 2009), subjecting Raymond Snyder to enforcement action by the Director;


WHEREAS, Raymond Snyder has been informed of the nature of the violation, of his right to counsel and of his right to contest any attempt by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, to discipline his license, or to recover whatever penalties or other monetary relief as may be provided for by statute, and states that he understands his rights to contest any such actions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of the institution by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration of any action to deny the renewal license of Raymond Snyder, or to impose any other penalties provided for by statute for the above-described violations, after being afforded the opportunity to consult legal counsel, Raymond Snyder does hereby voluntarily and knowingly surrender and forfeit the sum of \$250.00, such sum to be paid into the Missouri State School Fund pursuant to Sections 374.046 and 374.280, RSMo.


