VOLUNTARY FORFEITURE

It is hereby agreed by David Stanton and the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, as follows:

WHEREAS, John M. Huff is the duly appointed Director of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, State of Missouri, (hereinafter, Director) whose duties, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of insurance;

WHEREAS, the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration is charged with investigating producers and companies engaged in the business of insurance pursuant to Sections 374.085 and 374.190, RSMo 2000 and is authorized by the Director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to insurance;

WHEREAS, David Stanton has applied for his renewal license as a nonresident producer with the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo;


WHEREAS, information has been received by the Consumer Affairs Division that David Stanton failed to correctly answer on the renewal license application that he was the subject of an administrative action from the state of Florida, which is grounds for discipline under Section 375.141.1(1) RSMo (Supp. 2009), subjecting David Stanton to enforcement action by the Director;

WHEREAS, David Stanton has been informed of the nature of the violation, of his right to counsel and of his right to contest any attempt by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, to refuse his renewal, or to recover whatever penalties or other monetary relief as may be provided for by statute, and states that he understands his rights to contest any such actions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of the institution by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration of any action to deny the license of David Stanton, or to impose any other penalties provided for by statute for the above-described violations, after being afforded the opportunity to consult legal counsel, David Stanton does hereby voluntarily and knowingly surrender and forfeit the sum of \$250.00, such sum to be paid into the Missouri State School Fund pursuant to Sections 374.046 and 374.280, RSMo.





Dear Mr. Stanton:

The Missouri Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions, and Professional Registration has received your nonresident producer renewal application. You failed to correctly answer on the renewal application that you were the subject of an administrative action from the state of Florida. This matter is grounds for refusal of the nonresident producer license based on the following Missouri statute:

Section 375.141.1(1) RSMo (Supp. 2009) - The director may suspend, revoke, refuse to issue or refuse to renew an insurance producer license for any one or more of the following causes: Intentionally providing materially incorrect, misleading, incomplete or untrue information in the license application;

I am prepared to report this matter to the Director of the Missouri Department of Insurance with a recommendation to refuse to issue the renewal of your license, but in order to resolve this matter, I recommend that you pay a voluntary forfeiture in the amount of \$250.00. Please consider this option and consult with counsel if you wish.

Be aware that imposition of this fine is an administrative action that you may be required to report to other states in which you are licensed.

Enclosed is a Voluntary Forfeiture Agreement in the amount of \$250.00. Please date, sign, and return the original document with a cashier's check or money order made payable to the Missouri State School Fund. Please return the original to my attention.
