ORDER OF CONTINUANCE

On November 9, 2016, Anthem, Inc. (“Anthem”) and Cigna Dental Health of Missouri, Inc. and Cigna Healthcare of St. Louis, Inc. (“Cigna”) filed a Motion to Continue Form A Public Hearing, scheduled for November 17, 2016, regarding Anthem’s proposed acquisition of Cigna. Anthem and Cigna support their motion as follows:

The Form A public hearing, set for November 17, 2016, falls merely two business days before commencement of trial (November 21, 2016) in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in the case styled *United States of America, et al. v. Anthem, Inc., et al.*, Case No. 1:16-cv-01493 (the “Federal Trial”), also relating to Anthem’s proposed acquisition of Cigna. Several of the parties’ witnesses, including experts, who will testify at the Form A public hearing in this matter are also expected to testify and/or assist in trial preparation in connection with the Federal Trial. If the November 17th hearing date is not continued, the parties [Anthem and Cigna] will be prejudiced at both that hearing and the Federal Trial in that the parties and their witnesses will not have sufficient time to prepare and meaningfully participate in both matters.

Anthem and Cigna, therefore, request a continuance of the Form A public hearing from November 17, 2016 to a date to be reset upon request of the parties.

On November 9, 2016, the Division of Insurance Company Regulation (“Division”) filed its Reply to Motion to Continue Form A Public Hearing stating that the Division is prepared to go forward with the November 17, 2016 hearing, but does not object to the motion.

The record reflects that on October 3, 2016, Anthem filed a Request for Form A Hearing. The Hearing Officer issued an Order on October 4, 2016 directing the parties to “jointly submit multiple proposed dates for the setting of the Form A hearing.” On October 12, 2016, Anthem and the Division filed their Joint Motion to Set Form A Public Hearing indicating “November 17, 2016 to be a mutually convenient date for the Form A hearing.”

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, for good cause shown, that the motion for continuance is granted and the hearing scheduled for November 17, 2016 is cancelled. The hearing will be reset upon the request of the parties.
