VOLUNTARY FORFEITURE AGREEMENT

It is hereby agreed by Jacqueline Bergesch and the Division of Consumer Affairs (“Division”) of the Department of Commerce and Insurance, as follows:

WHEREAS, Chlora Lindley-Myers, is the duly appointed Director of the Department of Commerce and Insurance, State of Missouri (hereinafter, “Director” of the “Department”), whose duties, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of insurance;

WHEREAS, the Division is charged with investigating producers and companies engaged in the business of insurance pursuant to Sections 374.085 and 374.190, RSMo and is authorized by the Director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to bail bonds;

WHEREAS, Jacqueline Bergesch ("Bergesch") has applied to for a bail bond agent license with the Department, pursuant to Chapter 374, RSMo;

WHEREAS, the Division has received information concerning Bergesch's misstatement on her application, which is a violation of Section 374.210.1(1), RSMo (2016), and subjects Bergesch to enforcement action by the Director;

WHEREAS, Bergesch has been informed of her right to counsel and of her right to contest any attempt by the Department to refuse to issue her bail bond agent license, and states that she understands her rights to contest any such actions;


AND WHEREAS, Bergesch acknowledges and admits for purposes of this Agreement and for purposes of any future action by the Director or the Division based on an additional violation of the bail bond laws or regulations by Bergesch, in which action the Director or the Division alleges that the violations described herein form part of a course of conduct, a business practice, or other such series of similar violations, or that future violations by Bergesch are committed knowingly, intentionally or in conscious disregard of the law, by a misstatement on her application, and that such conduct violated Section 374.210.1(1), RSMo (2016);

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of any recommendation or initiation by the Division of any action based on the violation cited in this Agreement, and after being afforded the opportunity to consult legal counsel, Bergesch does hereby voluntarily and knowingly surrender and forfeit the sum of three hundred dollars (\$300.00), such sum to be paid into the State School Moneys Fund pursuant to Sections 374.046 and 374.280, RSMo.


Bergesch shall submit this sum to the Department by cashier's check or money order made payable to the State School Moneys Fund no later than January 28, 2021.

The parties agree that, should the Director or the Division in the future allege an additional violation of the bail bond laws or regulations by Bergesch, nothing in this Agreement shall preclude the Director or the Division from introducing Bergesch's admissions contained in this Agreement as evidence that the acts described herein form part of a course of conduct, a business practice, or other such series of similar violations, or for purposes of showing that such later alleged acts are committed knowingly, intentionally or in conscious disregard of the law.
