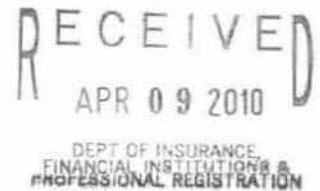

**VOLUNTARY FORFEITURE**

It is hereby agreed by Wendell Agee and the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, as follows:

WHEREAS, John M. Huff is the duly appointed Director of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, State of Missouri (hereinafter, Director) whose duties, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of insurance;

WHEREAS, the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration is charged with investigating producers and companies engaged in the business of insurance pursuant to Section 374.085, RSMo 2000 and is authorized by the Director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to insurance;

WHEREAS, Wendell Agee currently has a non-resident insurance producer renewal application pending in the state of Missouri with the Department of Insurance,

Financial Institutions and Professional Registration;

WHEREAS, information has been received by the Consumer Affairs Division concerning the renewal licensure application of Wendell Agee, in which Wendell Agee answered "no" to background question #2, "Have you been named or involved as a party in an administrative proceeding regarding any professional or occupational license or registration, which has not been previously reported to this state?" on his renewal application dated February 24, 2010. In August 2009, Agee was fined by the Kansas Department of Insurance for failure to report another state's action. Agee failed to report to the state of Kansas, Department of Insurance that he paid a voluntary forfeiture to the state of Missouri in March 2009. This misstatement on the producer application is a violation of Section 375.141.1(1), RSMo (Cum. Supp. 2009), and subjects Agee to enforcement action by the Director;


WHEREAS, Agee has been informed of the nature of his violations, of his right to counsel and of his right to contest any attempt by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, to refuse his insurance producer license, or to recover whatever penalties or other monetary relief as may be provided for by statute, and states that he understands his rights to contest any such actions;

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of the institution by the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration of any action to refuse the insurance producer license of Wendell Agee or to impose any other penalties provided for by statute for the above-described violations, after being afforded the opportunity to consult legal counsel, Wendell Agee does hereby voluntarily and knowingly surrender and forfeit the sum of two hundred fifty dollars (\$250), such sum to be paid into the Missouri State


School Fund pursuant to Sections 374.046 and 374.280, RSMo.

Wendell Agee shall submit this sum to the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, by cashier's check or money order made payable to the Missouri State School Fund no later than April 15, 2010.
