**ORDER REFUSING TO ISSUE INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE**

On May 2, 2017, the Consumer Affairs Division submitted a Petition to the Director alleging cause for refusing to issue a resident insurance producer license to Christopher D. Guebert. After reviewing the Petition and Investigative Report, the Director issues the following findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Christopher D. Guebert ("Guebert") is a Missouri resident with a residential, business, and mailing address of 100 Tuscany Lane, O'Fallon, Missouri 63366-4130.
2. On January 20, 2017, the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration received Guebert's electronic application for a resident insurance producer license ("Application").
3. Guebert answered "Yes" to Background Question 1B of the Application which asked, in relevant part: "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony?"
4. In further response to Background Question 1B, Guebert provided a letter of explanation and copies of court documents indicating that on April 29, 2013 he was convicted of Driving While Intoxicated - Alcohol - Persistent Offender, a Class D Felony, in violation of § 577.010.<sup>1</sup> *State v. Christopher D. Guebert*, Jefferson Co. Cir. Ct., Case No. 12JE-CR02734-01. The court sentenced Guebert to four years' incarceration, but suspended execution of the sentence and ordered him to complete five years' supervised probation. *Id.*

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

5. Section 375.141.1<sup>2</sup> provides, in relevant part:

The director may suspend, revoke, refuse to issue or refuse to renew an insurance producer license for any one or more of the following causes:

\* \* \*

(6) Having been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude[.]

6. The Director may refuse to issue a resident insurance producer license to Guebert pursuant to § 375.141.1(6) because he has been convicted of a felony, specifically Driving While Intoxicated - Alcohol - Persistent Offender, a Class D Felony, in violation of § 577.010. *State v. Christopher D. Guebert*, Jefferson Co. Cir. Ct., Case No. 12JE-CR02734-01.

7. The Director has considered Guebert's history and all of the circumstances surrounding Guebert's Application. Issuing a resident insurance producer license to Guebert would not be in the interest of the public. Accordingly, the Director exercises her discretion to refuse Guebert's Application for a resident insurance producer license.


8. This Order is in the public interest.


**ORDER**
