VOLUNTARY FORFEITURE AGREEMENT

It is hereby agreed by Michael Orasco and the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, as follows:

WHEREAS, John M. Huff, is the duly appointed Director of the Department of Insurance, Financial Institutions and Professional Registration, State of Missouri (hereinafter, "Director" of the "Department"), whose duties, pursuant to Chapters 374 and 375, RSMo, include the supervision and regulation of the business of bail bond;

WHEREAS, the Consumer Affairs Division of the Department is charged with investigating bail bond agents engaged in the bail bond business pursuant to Sections 374.085, 374.190 and 374.705, RSMo and is authorized by the Director to recommend enforcement action under the laws relating to bail bonds;

WHEREAS, Michael Orasco (“Applicant”) has applied to receive a bail bond license with the Department, pursuant to Chapter 374, RSMo;

WHEREAS, the Consumer Affairs Division has received information concerning Michael Orasco’s failure to disclose three (3) 1988 misdemeanors, which is a violation of Section 374.210.1(1), RSMo (Supp. 2012), and subjects Michael Orasco to enforcement action by the Director;

WHEREAS, Michael Orasco has been informed of his right to counsel and of his right to contest any attempt by the Department to refuse his bail bond license, and states that he understands his rights to contest any such actions;

AND WHEREAS, Michael Orasco acknowledges and admits for purposes of this Agreement and for purposes of any future action by the Director or the Consumer Affairs Division based on any additional violations of the bail bond laws or regulations by Michael Orasco, in which action the Director or the Consumer Affairs Division alleges that the violations described herein form part of a course of conduct, a business practice, or other such series of similar violations, or that future violations by Michael Orasco are committed knowingly, intentionally or in conscious disregard of the law, that he failed to report three (3) misdemeanors and that such conduct violated Section 374.210.1(1), RSMo;

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of any recommendation or initiation by the Consumer Affairs Division of any action based on the violation(s) cited in this Agreement, and after being afforded the opportunity to consult legal counsel, Michael Orasco does hereby voluntarily and knowingly surrender and forfeit the sum of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150.00), such sum to be paid into the State School Moneys Fund

pursuant to Sections 374.046 and 374.280, RSMo.

Michael Orasco shall submit this sum to the Department by cashier's check or money order made payable to the State School Moneys Fund no later than November 15, 2013.

The parties agree that, should the Director or the Division in the future allege an additional violation of the insurance laws or regulations by Michael Orasco, nothing in this Agreement shall preclude the Director or the Consumer Affairs Division from introducing Michael Orasco's admissions contained in this Agreement as evidence that the acts described herein form part of a course of conduct, a business practice, or other such series of similar violations, or for purposes of showing that such later alleged acts are committed knowingly, intentionally or in conscious disregard of the law.


