**ORDER REFUSING TO ISSUE RESIDENT INSURANCE PRODUCER LICENSE**

Angela L. Nelson, Director of the Missouri Department of Commerce and Insurance, takes up this matter for consideration and disposition. After reviewing the Petition, the Investigative Report, and other relevant documents, the Director issues these findings of fact, conclusions of law, and order

**FINDINGS OF FACTS**

1. William Robert Olson (“Olson”) is a resident of the state of Missouri with a reported residential, business and mailing address of 230 East Silver Creek, Forsyth, Missouri 65653.
2. On March 5, 2026, the Department of Commerce and Insurance (“Department”) received an electronic application for a resident insurance producer license (“Application”) from Olson.
3. Background Question No. 1B on his Application states:

Have you ever been convicted of a felony, had a judgment withheld or deferred, or are you currently charged with committing a felony? You may exclude juvenile adjudications (offenses where you were adjudicated delinquent in a juvenile court)

4. Olson answered “Yes” to Background Question No. 1B on his Application and provided certain documents, which he uploaded to the National Insurance Producer’s Registry (“NIPR”), Attachment Warehouse.
5. On March 10, 2026, Angie Gross (“Gross”), a Senior Regulatory Auditor with the Division, sent Olson an email asking for additional information about Olson’s criminal history. Among other things, the March 10, 2026, email asked for a certified copy of the indictment or information, complaint, judgment and sentence and including the status of any probation ordered in his criminal case.
6. On March 18, 2026, Gross received a certified copy of Olson’s criminal history referenced in Olson’s Application and the Attachment Warehouse.
7. The documents provided by Olson showed that on October 17, 2016, the Taney County Prosecuting Attorney filed a Felony Information, which charged Olson with a violation of section 566.034, RSMo, statutory rape in the second degree, a class C felony (Count I) and a violation of section 566.064, RSMo, statutory sodomy in the second degree, a class C felony (Count II). On March 30, 2017, Olson pled guilty to both of the felony charges. On that same date, the Taney County Circuit Court found Olson guilty of statutory rape in the second degree, a class C felony (Count I) and statutory sodomy in the second degree, a Class C felony. The court sentenced Olson to seven years’ imprisonment on both Counts, to be served concurrently, suspended execution of the two sentences and placed Olson on probation for a period of five years. On March 29, 2022, Olson was discharged from supervision by the Missouri Division of Probation and Parole. *State v. William R. Olson*, Taney Cty. Cir. Ct., Case No. 16AF-CRO1802-01.
8. Olson’s conviction resulted from an incident that occurred on June 17, 2016, when Olson, at the time 38 years of age, engaged in sexual relations with a girl, aged 16, knowing that the girl was sixteen years of age at the time of the incident. *Id.*
9. Olson is also registered as a Tier III Sexual Offender on the Sexual Offender Registry. *Id.*

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

10. Section 375.141, RSMo (2016), states, in relevant part:
  1. The director may suspend, revoke, refuse to issue or refuse to renew an insurance producer license for any one or more of the following causes:

\*\*\*

    - (6) Having been convicted of a felony or crime involving moral turpitude[.]

11. Section 566.034.1, RSMo provides as follows:

A person commits the offense of statutory rape in the second degree if being twenty-one years of age or older, he or she has sexual intercourse with another person who is less than seventeen years of age.

12. Section 566.064.1, RSMo provides as follows:

A person commits the offense of statutory sodomy in the second degree if being twenty-one years of age or older, he or she has deviate sexual intercourse with another person who is less than seventeen years of age.

13. The Director may refuse to issue Olson a resident insurance producer license pursuant to section 375.141.1(6) because Olson has been convicted of two felonies. *Id.*

14. Each felony conviction constitutes separate grounds for discipline.

15. The Director may refuse to issue Olson a resident insurance producer license pursuant to section 375.141.1(6) because he has been convicted of crimes involving moral turpitude. Olson was convicted of statutory rape in the second degree and statutory sodomy in the second degree, both of which are crimes involving moral turpitude. *Dept. of Health & Senior Services v. Adam R. Stover*, No. 02-1177DH (Mo. Admin. Hrg. Comm'n November 12, 2002) (holding that statutory rape is a crime involving moral turpitude).

16. Each conviction for a crime involving moral turpitude constitutes separate grounds for discipline.

17. Accordingly, and for all of the reasons given in this Petition, the Director has considered Olson's history and all of the circumstances surrounding Olson's Application and exercises her discretion to refuse Olson's Application for an insurance producer license.

18. This Order is in the public interest.

**ORDER**

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the insurance producer license application of **William Robert Olson** is hereby **REFUSED**.

**TO: Applicant and any unnamed persons aggrieved by this Order:**


